Rich Wacker is the former President and Chief Executive Officer of American Savings Bank (ASB). Prior to joining ASB, Rich was Chairman of Korea Exchange Bank (KEB), the fifth largest Korean commercial bank. He joined KEB in 2004 as Chief Operating Officer, was appointed President and CEO in 2005, adding the position of Chairman of the Board from 2007. Rich was integral in the establishment of the KEB Foundation, the first social welfare organization in the Korean financial industry, and was the organization's second Chairman. In 2008, Rich was recognized as one of Korea's "Most Respected CEOs." Rich also enjoyed a 20-year career with General Electric (GE) where he was a company officer and held a wide range of senior leadership positions in the U.S. and Europe.
